Receive written design approval from Grant PUD <u>prior</u> to installation.
Pay additional fees, if applicable, as determined by Grant PUD during the application review.
Obtain an electrical permit from Washington State L&I.
Complete the installation.
Request an electrical inspection from Washington State L&I. • All installations <u>must be</u> approved by Washington State L&I prior to interconnection.
 Request an interconnection inspection from Grant PUD by contacting Energy Services. Submit the Certificate of Completion with the approved Washington State L&I number to Grant PUD.
If approved, Grant PUD installs a bi-directional meter.
Start generating power.
